ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

Applicants into this program must have completed Diploma or Advanced Diploma qualification in related fields of study and three (3) years equivalent full-time relevant workplace experience at a significant level of leadership and management responsibility and/or complexity in an enterprise;

or

Applicants who have completed a Bachelor degree with two (2) years equivalent full-time relevant workplace experience at a significant level of leadership and management responsibility and/or complexity in an enterprise;

or

Applicants who have five (5) years equivalent full-time relevant workplace experience at a significant level of leadership and management responsibility and/or complexity in an enterprise.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

All applicants from a non-English speaking background must supply one of the following qualifications as a condition for admission:

- ▶ IELTS: Overall band score of 6.0
 - ▶ IBT (Internet-based TOEFL): Overall score of 75 with a writing section minimum of 21
 - ▶ Cambridge Certificate of Proficiency in English (CPE): Grades A, B, C and C1
 - ▶ Cambridge Certificate of Advanced English (CAE): Total score of 52 or over
 - ▶ English for Academic Purposes (EAP 2): Grade A or Grade B
 - ▶ PTE Academic Module with score over 51
 - ▶ Certificate IV in ESL
- Or
- ▶ Completed an AQF qualification (Cert IV or higher) with a minimum duration of one year full-time study.
 - ▶ The qualification must be less than 2 years old.
